## WHITLEY GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- Out of Bounds**  
All boundary hedges, fences and ditches mark out of bounds.  
The driving range is out of bounds while playing the 1st/10th/2nd/11th.  
The 9th/18th fairway and rough are out of bounds while playing the 4th/13th holes.  
The 4th/5th/13th/14th holes are out of bounds while playing the 9th/18th holes.
- Lateral/water hazards:**  
Lateral water hazards are identified by the red posts (Rule 26).  
Water hazards are identified by yellow posts.  
Anyone going into the water hazard or on to the island between the 5th/14th and 9th/18th holes, have the option of either playing it or dropping in the drop zone.  
The banking running up the left hand side of the 9th/18th is classified as rough where it is mown, and as part of the hazard where it has not been mown.
- Stones in bunkers are removable objects (Rule 24-1).**
- All paths and walkways on bridges are deemed immovable obstruction.** If the bridge causes inconvenience to your stance or swing you may also take relief in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i).
- Balls striking overhead power cables or pylons must be replayed without penalty.**
- Staked Trees:**  
A ball resting in such a position that damage may be caused by stance or swing **MUST** be lifted and dropped within 1 club length, not nearer the hole, without penalty.
- If when putting on any of the greens you find that one of the unused holes is in the way, you can take the nearest point of relief without penalty, so that you can have a clear putt.**
